



The Equality Authority report **Implementing Equality for Lesbians, Gays, Bisexuals** in 2002 examined a wide range of themes relevant to lesbians, gay and bisexual people. This has consequences, both in terms of the impact on the individual's health, social wellbeing and personal development, and in terms of lost contributions to the broader community."
